## CODE OF CONDUCT

### *GUIDELINES FOR CONDUCT OF PLAYERS AND OFFICIALS WHILE PARTICIPATING IN USACA ATLANTIC REGIONAL CRICKET BOARD TOURNAMENTS AND RELATED ACTIVITIES*

1. All players will comply with the instructions of an umpire, and will not criticize their decision by word or action, or show dissent, or generally behave in a manner on or off the field which may bring an umpire into disrepute.
2. Any difference of opinion with a player or ARCB official shall not be discussed publicly
3. All Players and officials are required to make themselves aware of all ICC Rules and Regulations available on ICC website ([icc-cricket.com](http://icc-cricket.com)), as modified by ICC from time to time. USACA and Atlantic Region Tournaments and activities may be governed by these Rules and Regulations.
4. Parents/Guardians/Team Official/League Official/Academy Official involvement during try-out process is prohibited. This is also applicable for tournaments and other region activities.
5. Violations of any of these guidelines may result in disciplinary actions including suspension from participating in Region try-outs, tournaments and activities.
